Overview

The Government Standards and Practices Commission:

- Interprets and applies government standards and practices laws as well as public meetings laws.
- Reviews public official and lobbyist conduct for all citizens of the state.
- Provides training to state and local governments on government standards and practices, and public meetings laws.

Balanced Budget

The Governor's balanced budget for the Commission is \$620,337 total funds. This is a 23 percent decrease from the 2001-03 Legislatively Approved Budget through the Fifth Special Session. The decrease is due to the phase out of one-time legal expenses and expenditure reductions made because of General Fund shortfalls. The balanced budget allows the agency to sustain a minimal level of services, but decreases staffing by one-fourth.

Revenue

General Fund is the main source of funding for the Commission. Other Funds are charges to pay the cost of publications.
