
RULE SUMMARY

The Department of Human Services, Public Health Division is proposing to permanently amend OAR 333-012-0500 to reflect the statutory requirements of SB 796 (Oregon Laws 2009, chapter 709). This action will allow the Public Health Division to increase the maximum reimbursement cap to licensed funeral service practitioners for the cost of services provided for disposition of unclaimed indigent bodies. The maximum reimbursement cap was previously set in ORS 97.170(5). SB 796, Section 8 removed the maximum reimbursement cap from statute and directs establishment of the maximum reimbursement cap to OAR 333-012-0500. The maximum reimbursement cap is presently set at \$450 and this rulemaking will increase the maximum reimbursement cap to \$650.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing the negative economic impact of the rule on business.
